## Release and Hold Harmless Agreement

WHEREAS, the UNDERSIGNED acknowledges the inherent risks involved in riding and working around horses, which risks include bodily injury from using, riding or being in close proximity to horses, among other risks, and further, that both horse and rider can be injured in normal use or in competition and schooling;

IN CONSIDERATION, therefore, for the privilege of riding and/or working around horses at OSAGE BOARDING STABLES, INC., the Undersigned does hereby agree to hold harmless and indemnify OSAGE BOARDING STABLES, INC. and further release them from any liability or responsibility for accident, damage, injury, or illness to the Undersigned or any horse owned by the Undersigned or to any family member or spectator accompanying the Undersigned while on the premises of OSAGE BOARDING STABLES, INC.; and that except in the event of this stable's gross and willful negligence, I shall bring no claims, demands, actions and causes of action, and/or litigation, against this stables for any economic and non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, and/or property damage sustained by me and/or my minor child or legal ward in relation to the premises and operations of this stable, including while riding, handling, or otherwise being near horses owned by or in the care, custody and control of this stable.

**INHERENT RISKS:** Inherent risks of domestic animal activities include, but shall not be limited to:

- a) The propensity of a domestic animal to behave in ways, i.e, running, bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an injury, harm or death to persons on or around them;
- b) The unpredictability of a domestic animal's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals;
- c) Certain hazards such as surface and sub-surface conditions;
- d) Collisions with other domestic animals or objects; and

- e) The potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the domestic animal or not acting within such participant's ability.

**WARNING**

Under Kansas law, there is no liability for an injury to or the death of a participant in domestic animal activities resulting from the inherent risks of domestic animal activities, pursuant to K.S.A. 60-4001 through 60-4004. You are assuming the risk of participating in this domestic animal activity.
